Important information for Swimmers and Parents about swimmers punctuality and behaviour

In line with the Club Code of Conduct we would like to remind swimmers and parents of their responsibility to arrive on time for training sessions, **this means being ready poolside at the set time, either 7pm or 4.30pm.**

A number of swimmers are continually arriving poolside late as they are taking 15-20 minutes in the changing rooms. Lateness causes disruption to the session and for those swimmers who arrive on time.

All swimmer **MUST** be in the water no later than 5 minutes after the start of the session. Any swimmer who is later than this time will be refused entry to the session, unless prior notification has been given or the parent comes poolside to explain the reason for lateness.

A letter will be sent home with any swimmer who is refused entry due to lateness which parents must sign to confirm they are aware of what has happened. The swimmer will not be allowed into the next session unless the signed form is returned and given to one of the teachers.

We also expect swimmers to behave (this includes paying attention and training) during sessions. A warning will be given to swimmers who continually misbehave. A swimmer who has been given 3 warning will be asked to leave the session. Likewise a letter will be sent home for parents to sign and return.

If a swimmer is continually late, with no good reason or asked to leave a session a result of misbehaviour then a meeting will be arranged with parents to discuss how the matter can be resolved.
